Come and compete in the 15th annual Northeast Bicycle Club kids-only bicycle race, sponsored by the Northeast Bicycle Club, the Cycle Loft and the Winchester Rotary Club.

Races for kids 12 and under held "rain or shine" under USA Cycling permit and officiated by USA Cycling officials. All racers must wear CPSC-approved helmets (look inside the helmet safety certification). Parents and guardians are responsible for bicycle safety and working condition.

Field Limits: 5 to 8 year olds: 25 racers. Two heats held if more than 25 racers are present. All other ages: 50 racers. Separate boys and girls races may be held. Competing in more than one race is encouraged, including competing against older racers.

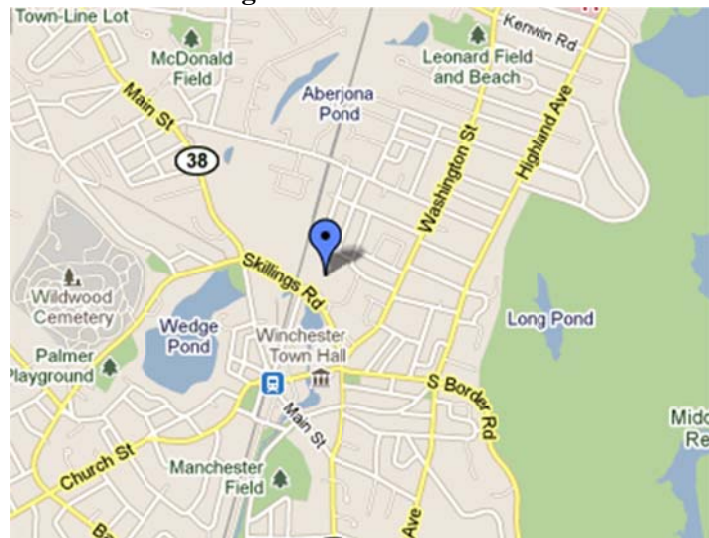

Directions

Rte. 128 to Exit 33A, Rte. 3
 South on Rte. 3/Cambridge St. for 3.5 Miles
 Left on Church St. continue for .3 miles
 Left onto Fletcher St. continue for .2 miles
 Right onto Skillings Road.
 Skillings Field at Winchester High School will be on the right.

Race Courses:

- 100m track sprints held on cinder track.
- Grass Races held on the flat grassy turf inside the track.
- Grass criteriums held on a 1 KM marked loop surrounding Skillings Field with start and finish at the main entrance to the field.
- Pursuit races held on cinder track.

Support:

Members of the Northeast Bicycle Club will marshal the events and encourage, mentor and assist all racers. Mechanical assistance will be provided on the field by a skilled mechanic.

Registration:

FREE!!! Includes USA Cycling one day license and insurance for riders 10 yrs old and up. A donation of \$5 per racer to help with organizational expenditures will be greatly appreciated.

REMEMBER:

One of the registered and competing racers will win a raffled junior bicycle offered by the Cycle Loft!

N.B. Parent or guardian MUST be present to sign competitors' registration and entry forms. Make sure that names, address and telephone numbers are correct and legible. If you are the winner of the bike but you are not present on the field at 11:00, the bicycle will be given to another contender! Riders not wearing a CPSC-approved helmet will regretfully not be allowed to race.
